



NEW FOOTBALL OFFICIALS CLASS

The Indiana Officials Association (IOA) offers this program for individuals interested in officiating youth and high school football. Experienced officials will guide you through your first year as an official—from obtaining your license to working games at an appropriate level.

- Step 1. **Registration.** The course is open to the first 20 paid applicants or June 30, whichever comes first. Complete and mail registration form (below) with payment to secure your place in the class. The course fee includes IOA and IFOA membership, materials, and instruction. The IHSAA fee rule books and exam is not included. Information on this will be covered at the first class. **Register Now!**
- Step 2. **Rules Study** on Wednesdays between 6 – 9pm **June 30 – July 7 – July 14 – July 21**
- Step 3. **IHSAA Licensure Exam** between 6 – 8pm at Farm Bureau **July 28**
- Step 4. **Mechanics Study** on Wednesdays between 6 – 9pm **August 4 – August 11 – August 18**
Practical Clinic with on-field experience at a local high school **August 6**
- Step 5. **Association Meetings** on most Wednesdays in August and September with presentations and video provided for all IOA football officials.
